By order of the Deputy Chairman of the Investigative Committee of Russian Federation B.M. Karnaukhov, I inform you that the Investigative Committee of Russian Federation has reviewed your appeal regarding an inadequate inspection of the Atommash OJSC premeditated bankruptcy case by the law enforcement agencies, which we received from the Presidential Executive Office of Russian Federation.

The said appeal contains no issues within the competence of the Investigative Committee of Russian Federation.

According to ch. 151 of the Criminal Procedure Code of Russian Federation, crimes under ch. 196 of the Criminal Code of Russian Federation (premeditated bankruptcy) are assigned to the investigative jurisdiction of the investigators of the Minister of Interior; inspections of this fact have previously been conducted by the staff of the MoI and prosecutors of the Rostov region, and, since under Law of 17.01.1992 №2202-1 "About the Prosecutors of Russian Federation" it is the prosecutor who supervises the execution of laws by authorities who carry out operational and search activity, inquiry and preliminary investigation, your appeal has been redirected, as appropriate, to the General Prosecutor's Office of Russian Federation.

The prosecutor bodies of Russian Federation will notify you on the results of the review of the appeal.

If you disagree with the decision, you may appeal to a higher supervisor or to the court.
