Dear colleagues!

We ask you to be extremely wary about your relations with Sergey Pavlovich Yakunin, the head of YACONTO LLC.

We hereby inform you that our company suffered significant losses as a result of our partnership with YACONTO Company; criminal proceedings were started against the company's leaders.

Here is the situation: our company signed a contract with YACONTO for services on certification of goods imported to Russia; after an analysis of documents received from YACONTO, the transport police directorate of Novorossiysk instituted criminal proceedings on forgery and embezzlement of other's property (money).
