Dear Yuriy Yakovlevich!

In accordance with the Orders of the President of Russian Federation from June 29th, 2010 NPr-1883 and from August 21st, 2010 NPr-2448 the Presidential Control Directorate of Russian Federation continues to conduct an investigation of the accident of bankruptcy and forced liquidation of Atommash OJSC (Volgodonsk, Rostov region) where the State owned 30% stake. General Prosecutor's Office of Russian Federation examines the validity and justification of the previously made decisions not to initiate criminal proceedings on the fact of the intentional bankruptcy of Atommash OJSC.

The President of YACONTO LLC (RF, Moscow) S.P. Yakunin appealed to me (N \ge 110201-A02 from 01.02.2011), asking to send to you a Complaint of YACONTO LLC (N \ge 110201-A01 from 01.02.2011) regarding the verification of Atommash OJSC bankruptcy case materials. YACONTO LLC, being the successor of Concern YACONTO JSC (RF, Moscow) was the owner of 28.5% stake in Atommash OJSC. Hence, Concern YACONTO JSC, as well as the State which owned 30% interest in Atommash OJSC, has been deprived of its property because of the bankruptcy.

I request you to instruct the General Prpsecutor's Office to conduct a thorough check on the Complaint of YACONTO LLC (Nº110201-A1 from 01.02.2011) and to ensure the protection of Russia's national interests in the investigation of the unprecedented bankruptcy case of Atommash OJSC.
